“I went behind the car and I still didn't knew someone were dead, I just thought it was serious, but not that serious. Then I found Kari, and her head was jammed between the wheel and the rear mudguard. Her head has been pulled up, and was dead instantly”

“Then I found Allan. I said to him. “Allan, this is bad. This is really bad”. His body heat was still normal. “This, is really bad,” I said. Then I felt something in my hand, that didn't feel right. I turned him around and saw, his other side was injured. His neck was broken.....”

*Sign: Kasper was sitting next to Kim as they crashed*

“To me he didn't seem that drunk. I hadn't been drunk with him that many times before, so I really didn't know, how he was acting, when he was drunk.”

“I didn't think that much about it. I just thought about getting home. I didn't want to wait for a taxi, and it was too expensive, I thought.”

*Sign: Kari and Allan died*

“I thought, it was a lie. I didn't think, this could happen just by turning the car upside down. I just thought it was part of a movie, it wasn't something happening in real life. But it was.....Then I just shouted. I didn't know what to do”
