

- → Liverpool City Region includes:

Culture and Heritage

Awarded coveted title of European Capital of Culture 2008 by UK Government and European Parliament because:

- Over 800 years of heritage
- → 32 museums and galleries including:
 - → Walker Art Gallery
 - → Tate Liverpool
 - → Lady Lever Art Gallery
- Largest Anglican cathedral in the world
- Neo Classical buildings and the largest collection of listed and Georgian buildings in the country
 - → St George's Hall
 - → Albert Dock
 - Speke Hall





Maritime

- → At the turn of the century Liverpool was the largest transatlantic port
- → Largest emigration port 1830-1930 with nine million emigrants from Europe to USA
- → Birthplace to first passenger cruise liner Cunard
- → 'Three Graces' on the waterfront lasting legacy:
 - → Port of Liverpool
 - Cunard
 - → Royal Liver
- Merseyside Maritime Museum (largest in Europe) tells the story of Liverpool's Maritime Heritage including:
 - Luisitania
 - → Titanic
 - → Battle of the Atlantic





Sport

- → Two English Premiership soccer teams Liverpool (the most successful team in the country) and Everton
- Home to the world's most famous steeplechase The Martell Grand National incorporating the Grand National Festival
- → England's Golfing Capital with seven championship golf courses including:
 - → Royal Liverpool (home of the Open 2006)
 - → Royal Birkdale (home of the Open 2008)

- Birthplace to the world's most famous band The Beatles!
- → Take a tour:
 - → The Beatles Story
 - → Childhood homes of Paul McCartney and John Lennon
 - → Magical Mystery Tour
 - Cavern Club
